- Usability and user-centered design
- Information design and delivery
- Documentation
- Structured authoring
- Principals of XML formats
- DITA
- DocBook

The Graduate Diploma of Social Science (Technical Communication) incorporates the Graduate Certificate program. The first four units are offered online, with the final four units taught in face-to-face classes throughout the semester with students attending a weekly evening class for each unit.

Admission requirements for both courses are an undergraduate degree from a recognised university. In special circumstances applications from non-graduates with at least two years industry experience may be considered.

The teaching semester starts on 1 March and runs for 12 teaching weeks with a one-week mid-semester break. Applications close on 19 February.
